SECTION: TREASURES IN PROVERBS TOPIC: Wisdom and Folly

INTRODUCTION

A beautiful description of wisdom is found in the book of James, also called the *Proverbs of the New Testament*. "But the wisdom from above is first pure, then peaceable, gentle, reasonable, full of mercy and good fruits, unwavering, without hypocrisy". This wisdom is in the spiritual realm and involves discernment between good and evil and the commitment to good. Whenever you see the word "wisdom" in Proverbs, think "righteousness" and you will be on the right track. In the same way, the word foolish can be interpreted as "evil".
