⁴ Phoenicia: the land north of Palestine on the eastern shore of the Mediterranean Sea.

⁵ Samaria: In the time of Jesus, Palestine was divided into three provinces: Galilee, Samaria, and Judea.

⁶ Pharisees: a legalistic party among the Jews that believed in immortality of the soul, resurrection of the body, and the existence of angels and spirits.
