Sagrippa: Herod Agrippa II, son of Herod Agrippa I and great-grandson of Herod the Great who killed the Bethlehem babies. He was appointed by the Roman Emperor Claudius as ruler of Ablene, part of Galilee, Iturea, and Trachonitis.

⁶ Bernice: daughter of Herod Agrippa I, sister of Herod Agrippa II. According to the historian Josephus, she was first married to a man named Marcus and later to her uncle Herod, king of Chalcis, who soon afterward died. She later married Polemo, king of Cilicia, but deserted him shortly after their wedding. Then she made her way to Jerusalem, where she lived with Agrippa II.
